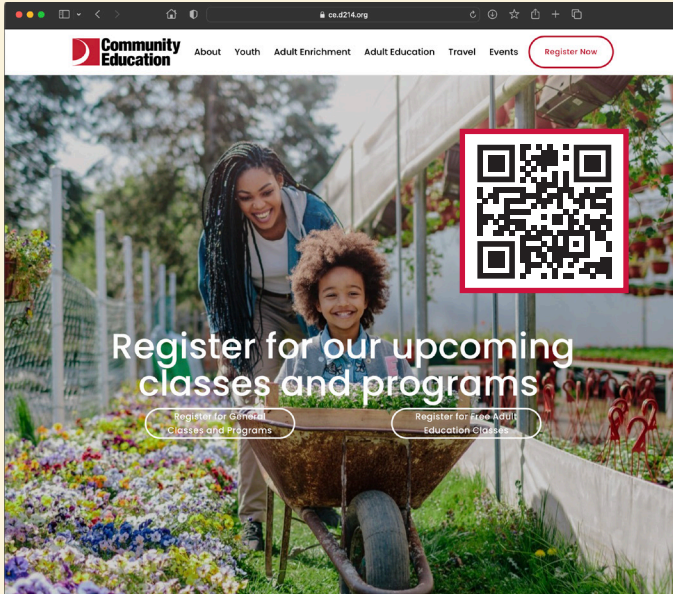

Sock Monkeys & The Treasures of Halim!

■ **Thursday, June 1, 2023**

Join CET for a unique tour as we see some of Chicagoland's more unusual collections at one of the area's newest museums, the Halim Time & Glass Museum, a spectacular five-story building in Evanston and the world's first museum dedicated solely to stained glass and clocks from all over the world. The collection includes more than 1,100 clocks and over 30 painstakingly restored floor-to-ceiling stained glass windows from American and European artists. After lunch, we visit the adjacent Sock Monkey Museum! From its origins in Rockford, at the Nelson Knitting Company, these unique red-heeled socks became toys during the Great Depression. Here see one of the world's largest vintage Sock Monkey collections. Learn about the socks used to make the monkeys as well as the history of socks through the ages. As a special treat, you will make your own Sock Monkey!

Blockbuster Exhibition! - Andy Warhol: A Life in Pop

A new Blockbuster Exhibition is coming to the McAninch Arts Center and Cleve Carney Museum of Art at the College of DuPage in the summer of 2023! The works from the Andy Warhol Portfolios: A Life in Pop is a highly anticipated must-see! The Warhol Exhibition will include 94 works, including interactive experiences, a video archive installation, over 150 photos taken by Warhol, a Studio 54 experience and a Central Park-inspired outdoor café, creating an immersive, multifaceted exhibition focused on the life and work of one of the most influential artists of the past century!

Yellowstone National Park
