## Important Instructions for Day Trip Reservations

- Reservations will be accepted beginning Thursday, February
   17-and not before! NEW!! You can now book your own tours online. Instructions on how to do so will be emailed prior to the registration date.
- 2. Online registration begins at 8 a.m. on February 17. If you are unable to reserve your tours online, beginning at 1 p.m. on February 17, you can email your selections to cetravel@ d214.org (emails are preferred) or phone 847-718-7709. If you reach voicemail, leave a message to include your name, phone number and the trips you want booked. You can make up to four reservations with your call/email but we must have complete names, phone numbers and emails for each person and they must be aware you are calling for them.
- To be fair, a certain number of seats have been allocated for each trip for online registrations as well as email/phone reservations.
- 4. No in-person reservations will be accepted. Please do not come to the CET office.



## **Important Instructions for Day Trip Reservations**

- 5. CET accepts credit/debit cards only for payment (exceptions made for those who do not have a credit/ debit card). Your credit card will be required at time of booking, but will not, however, be charged at that time. We will automatically charge your card 60 days prior to the trip unless the trip is within 60 days, in which case we will charge your card at time of reservation. If you email or leave a message with your Day Trip selections, do not include your credit/debit card number in your email or phone message, we will contact you for the necessary information. If you've taken a CET Day Trip within the past few months, we already have your credit card securely on file.
- 6. Once your reservation is confirmed, we will email (or postal mail if you do not have an email) your confirmation that will include the date your credit/debit card will be charged.
- 7. Any CET Discounts you have should be mentioned at time of reservation and mailed in prior to final payment, as no discounts will be refunded after final payment is charged. The only discounts accepted for Day Trips are CET Day Trip Rewards (three rewards equal three points for \$10 off a trip) and Birthday Cards. Gold Cards are not applicable for day tours.
- 8. Cancellations after the final payment is charged are nonrefundable unless a replacement is found, in which case we will refund you less a \$10 administrative fee.
- 9. Approximately two weeks prior to the date of your Day Trip you will receive final instructions via email or postal mail if you do not have email. This letter will give you details such as where to board the motorcoach, times, Tour Director and other details relevant to the trip.
- 10.Proof of COVID-19 vaccination(s) may be required if any of our suppliers (theatre, restaurant, motorcoach company, etc) require proof of vaccination. You will be notified if this is the case. Theatres currently have both proof of vaccination mandates and mask requirements in place. All travelers will be asked to sign a waiver of liability prior to your trip. Face masks. hand sanitizing and social distancing on CET Tours will be enforced based on the COVID-19 mitigation regulations at the time of your trip.
