DAY 3 Breakfast. Explore the Maine Wildlife Park in Gray, Maine to see more than 30 different species of Maine wildlife including moose, bald eagles and black bear. Free time in Freeport, Maine, home of L.L. Bean's flagship store. Visit the Maine Maritime Museum in Bath, Maine to learn about Maine's maritime heritage. Dinner.

DAY 4 Breakfast. Enjoy scenic fall foliage travel through the New England countryside of Maine. Cruise along the Atlantic Ocean Coastline. Keep an eye out for seals, bald eagles and osprey. Free time for lunch & shopping in Boothbay Harbor. Visit the charming seaside
